Hi Angelique,

I received Jessica's response regarding PDs role on the AlertSCC item for this Thursday, however, the *Use of Privately Owned Surveillance Cameras*, item d3, is also on the agenda. In reading the memo (attached), several changes were made to the memo which the Department did not get to comment on. In particular where the memo states that the "Department will determine whether adequate staffing exists to manage the data" in the Evaluation & Follow Up section.

It has been the Department's position that we cannot manage this dataset because we do not have the resources to do so. If discussions were had where the Department was going to take this on, please advise and I apologize in advance for not keeping informed of this.

As a result, please advise how this issue will be addressed and also PDs role on this item for Thursday.
