SYNOPSIS

(1VI) ETTTELBRICK was attempting to retrieve a wallet and a retired San Jose Police badge belonging to her boyfriend (1OT) GONZALEZ from an Uber driver (1OF) STAMPOLIS who was refusing to give up the wallet. While on the phone with MHPD Dispatchers, (1VI) ETTTELBRICK was in front of the vehicle (1OF) STAMPOLIS was driving and was relaying the license plate to dispatchers, (1OF) STAMPOLIS drove his vehicle forward striking (1VI) ETTTELBRICK in the leg. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK did not have visible injuries and had complaint of pain to her left knee. (1OF) STAMPOLIS dropped off the wallet and badge at MHPD. (1OF) STAMPOLIS declined to give any of his personal information to police and left the location.

NARRATIVE

SUMMARY :

On 01/08/19, (1VI) ETTTELBRICK attempted to retrieve a wallet belonging to her boyfriend (1OT) LOBDELL from an Uber driver (1OF) STAMPOLIS. When (1OF) STAMPOLIS refused to give the wallet, (1VI) ETTTELBRICK jumped in front (1OF) STAMPOLIS to restrict him from leaving and to obtain the license plate to give to MHPD Dispatchers. During this incident, (1VI) ETTTELBRICK claimed she was struck by (1OF) STAMPOLIS' vehicle.

DISPOSITION :

Case forward to DA's Office for review.

NARRATIVE:

On 01/08/19, at 1504 hours, I, Officer Tacazon #232 was dispatched to 17500 Monterey Road (Noah's Bar and Bistro) regarding a disturbance. I arrived on scene at 1508 hours. Officer Farrell #256 was on scene prior to my arrival. Officer Farrell #256 advised me to contact (1OF) STAMPOLIS, who was sitting in the driver's seat of a 2011, Buick SUV, pewter in color, California license plate of 6NYG060.

COURT

I contacted the male driver, who was later identified as (1OF) STAMPOLIS. I asked him for his name and he refused to give me his name. (1OF) STAMPOLIS then asked me if we had any reason to detain him. As he was asking me the question, I noticed a female passenger, later identified as (2OT) BUTTNER was sitting in the passenger seat, video recording me and Officer Farrell with her cell phone. I explained to (1OF) STAMPOLIS that we were investigating a possible possession of a stolen property.

I asked (1OF) STAMPOLIS if he had a wallet with him, that did not belong to him and he said yes. I asked (1OF) STAMPOLIS if he could give the wallet to (1VI) ETTTELBRICK and he said no, the wallet does not belong to her. I then asked (1OF) STAMPOLIS who that wallet belongs to and he said "Todd Gonzalez".

I spoke to (1VI) ETTTELBRICK, who stated the wallet belongs to her boyfriend (1OT) LOBDELL, who is a retired San Jose Police Officer and that the wallet contained his retired San Jose Police badge. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said (1OT) LOBDELL had to leave for San Jose for his job so she waited for (1OF) STAMPOLIS at the location, so she could get the wallet. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said (1OF) STAMPOLIS tried to leave so she called police.

(1OF) STAMPOLIS said he did not feel comfortable leaving (1OT) LOBDELL's wallet with anyone other than (1OT) LOBDELL. (1OF) STAMPOLIS said he was going to drop off (1OT) LOBDELL's wallet at Uber's headquarters in San Jose. I explained to (1OF) STAMPOLIS that we could take custody of the wallet and we would return the wallet to the rightful owner. (1OF) STAMPOLIS refused and Sgt. Thomas #223 was notified and responded to our location.

Sgt. Thomas convinced (1OF) STAMPOLIS to drop off the wallet to MHPD. (1OF) STAMPOLIS drove to MHPD where he dropped off the wallet. (1OF) STAMPOLIS demanded a property receipt. I responded to MHPD lobby where I met with (1OF) STAMPOLIS and asked him for his ID card, so I could complete the property receipt. (1OF) STAMPOLIS refused to let me see his ID card and declined to give any further information. (1OF) STAMPOLIS then left MHPD.

Sgt. Thomas advised me that (1VI) ETTTELBRICK was enroute to the police station to file an assault with a deadly weapon report. I met with (1VI) ETTTELBRICK at the police lobby where she gave me the following statement in summary:

STATEMENT OF (1VI) BELINDA ETTTELBRICK:

(1VI) ETTTELBRICK said her boyfriend (1OT) LOBDELL took an Uber 5 days ago. The next day, (1OT) LOBDELL realized that he didn't have his wallet with him, so he called Uber the next day. The Uber driver (1OF) STAMPOLIS called (1OT) LOBDELL the next day and told (1OT) LOBDELL that he looked all over the back seat of his vehicle and could not find his wallet. Later that day, (1OF) STAMPOLIS called (1OT) LOBDELL back and told him that he had found his wallet.

(1OT) LOBDELL told (1VI) ETTTELBRICK that (1OF) STAMPOLIS was going to meet him today at Noah's Bar to drop off his wallet at around 2:00 PM - 4:00 PM. (1OT) LOBDELL texted (1OF) STAMPOLIS back, but (1OF) STAMPOLIS was not answering back to his texts. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said (1OT) LOBDELL was worried because (1OF) STAMPOLIS had his badge and wallet. (1OT) LOBDELL asked (1VI) ETTTELBRICK if she could meet up with (1OF) STAMPOLIS to get his wallet because (1OT) LOBDELL had to go to work. in San Jose.

(1VI) ETTTELBRICK said (1OT) LOBDELL accidentally left his cell phone behind when he left for work. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said (1OF) STAMPOLIS called (1OT) LOBDELL's cell phone and (1VI) ETTTELBRICK answered and asked where he was at. (1OF) STAMPOLIS said he was supposed to meet up with (1OT) LOBDELL at Noah's Bar. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK told (1OF) STAMPOLIS she was across the street and was walking to his location.

(1VI) ETTTELBRICK meets up with (1OF) STAMPOLIS and asked if he was the Uber driver and he replied yes. (1OF) STAMPOLIS told (1VI) ETTTELBRICK that he was to meet with (1OT) LOBDELL.

(1VI) ETTERBRICK told (1OF) STAMPOLIS that she was (1OT) LOBDELL's girlfriend and that she was there to get (1OT) LOBDELL's wallet. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said she saw (1OF) STAMPOLIS holding a wallet in his hand. (1OF) STAMPOLIS told (1VI) ETTTELBRICK that she needed to sign papers if he was to give her the wallet.

(1OF) STAMPOLIS walked back to his car then came out and asked (1VI) ETTTELBRICK, where's the money? (1OF) STAMPOLIS told (1VI) ETTTELBRICK that (1OT) LOBDELL was going to give him money for his wallet. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK replied that she did not know anything about any money. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK asked for the wallet from (1OF) STAMPOLIS and he told her no and went towards his car. (1OF) STAMPOLIS turns around and gets close to (1VI) ETTTELBRICK's face and tells her that she can't get near her or he was going to kill her. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK asks for the wallet again and (1OF) STAMPOLIS threatens (1VI) ETTTELBRICK and said if she gets near him, he's going to kill her and that he wasn't going to give her the wallet.

(1OF) STAMPOLIS gets inside her car and (1VI) ETTTELBRICK tells him that he can't leave without giving her the wallet. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK told (1OF) STAMPOLIS that he can't leave with that badge also. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK tells (1OF) STAMPOLIS that she was going to call police if he tries to leave. (1OF) STAMPOLIS tells (1VI) ETTTELBRICK to call police. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK calls MHPD and the Dispatchers asked for the license plate, so (1VI) ETTTELBRICK jumps in front of the vehicle to get the license plate and (1OF) STAMPOLIS drives his vehicle forward and hits (1VI) ETTTELBRICK's left leg. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said she had complaint of pain to her left knee. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said she placed her hands on the hood when she got hit. MHPD Dispatchers asked what make and model the vehicle was and the vehicle kept going forward. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK said a male witness, who she thinks was an off-duty police officer witnessed the incident.

(1OF) STAMPOLIS told (1VI) ETTTELBRICK to get out of the way and that's when the male witness, who was identified as (1WI) WALKER walked up to (1OF) STAMPOLIS and identified himself and (1OF) STAMPOLIS asked (1WI) WALKER if he was "on duty" or "off-duty". (1VI) ETTTELBRICK heard (1WI) WALKER say he was "on-duty" 24-hours a day. (1OF) STAMPOLIS was trying to leave and (1WI) WALKER told (1OF) STAMPOLIS to wait until police arrived, but (1OF) STAMPOLIS was trying to leave and that's when police arrived. **(End of Statement)**

I asked (1VI) ETTTELBRICK if she needed medical attention and she refused. (1VI) ETTTELBRICK did not have any visible injuries. I took photographs of (1VI) ETTTELBRICK's left knee. (Attached to this case.)

INJURY TO:

Complaint of pain to (1VI) ETTTELBRICK's left knee.

I spoke to (1WI) WALKER, who told me the following statement in summary:

STATEMENT OF (1WI) MICHAEL WALKER:

(1WI) WALKER said he was inside the Noah's bar when he heard yelling. (1WI) WALKER said he did not see (1VI) ETTTELBRICK get hit with the car. (1WI) WALKER said he was near the rear of (1OF) STAMPOLIS' vehicle and was taking a picture of his license plate. (1WI) WALKER said the vehicle was moving back and forth, but stopped its movement, when police arrived. **(End of Statement)**

I ran the vehicle registered owner information through a law enforcement open source data and located a (1OF) CHRISTOPHER STAMPOLIS associated with the registered vehicle address. MHPD Dispatchers printed out a Cal-Photo of (1OF) STAMPOLIS, which was a positive match on the suspect I contacted at the original call location. I contacted (1OF) STAMPOLIS via cell phone, who told me the following statement in summary:

STATEMENT OF (1OF) CHRISTOPHER STAMPOLIS:

(1OF) STAMPOLIS said (1VI) ETTTELBRICK was in front of his vehicle, but he did not hit her, nor did he move his vehicle when she was in front of his vehicle. (1OF) STAMPOLIS told (1VI) ETTTELBRICK to call police.

(1OF) STAMPOLIS then said while he was moving his vehicle forward, (1VI) ETTTELBRICK jumped in front his vehicle and (1VI) ETTTELBRICK hit his vehicle. (1OF) STAMPOLIS said she did this twice, then she stepped away from his vehicle. (1OF) STAMPOLIS then said he wanted to press false imprisonment charges against (1VI) ETTTELBRICK from restricting his movement from leaving. **(End of Statement)**

I then spoke to (2OT) BUTTNER, who told me the following statement in summary:

STATEMENT OF (2OT) ANNETTE BUTNER:

I asked (2OT) BUTTNER if she saw (1OF) STAMPOLIS hitting (1VI) ETTTELBRICK with his car and she said, "That never happened." (2OT) BUTTNER said (1VI) ETTTELBRICK stepped in front of (1OF) STAMPOLIS' car, restricting him from leaving. (2OT) BUTTNER said the car was stopped. (2OT) BUTTNER said she has a video of the incident on her cell phone and said she will retain the video. **(End of Statement)**
